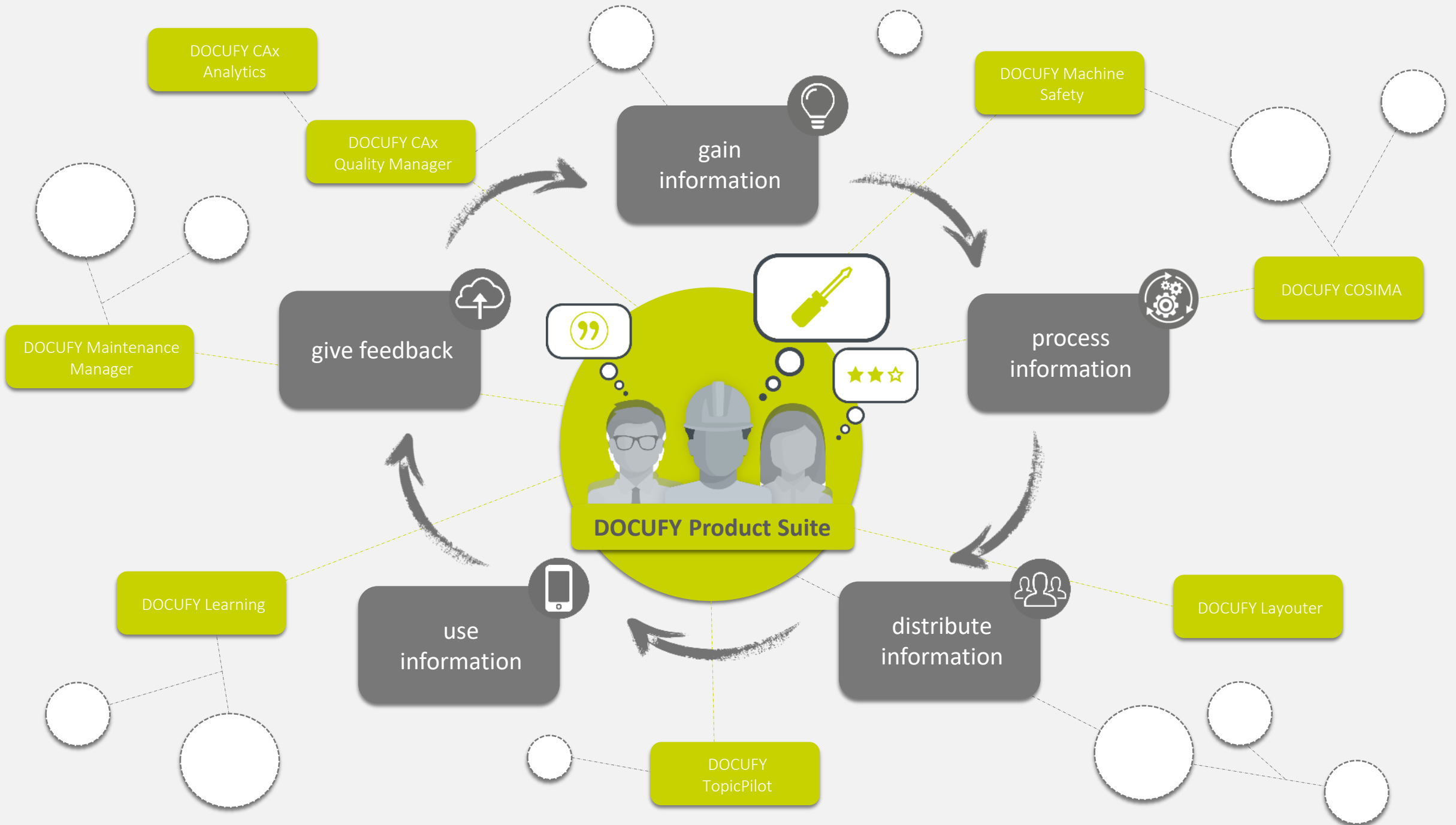

What we use for Paged Media

- A) Component Content Management System storing valid XML
- B) Web-based tool to prepare CSS-based “Layouts packages”
- C) AntennaHouse Formatter

To create output formats we process XML data with XSLT pipelines, surprise!

PS: We also use XSL-FO, of course.

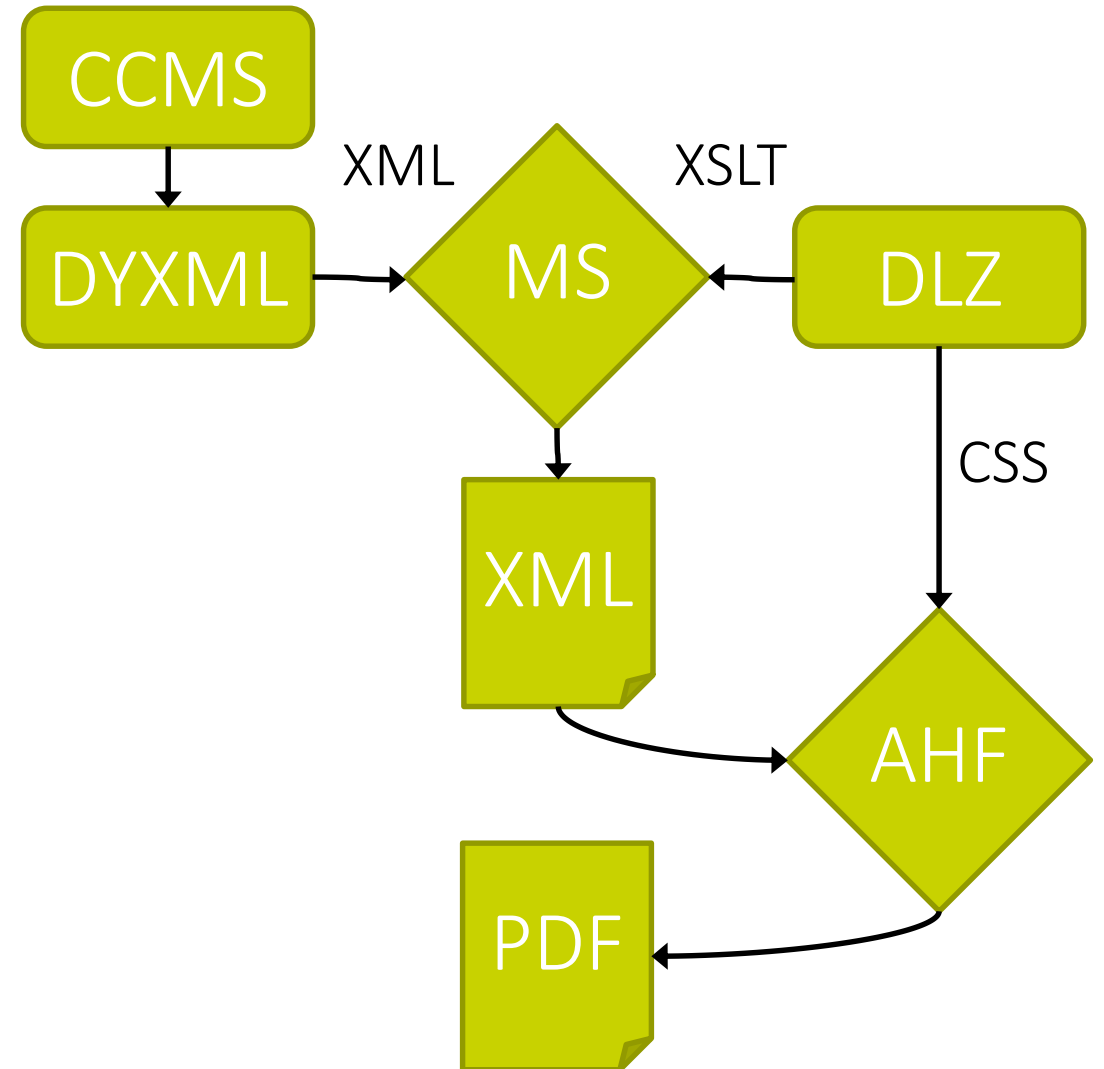
Our formatting process

DYXML Data package: Standardized XML for Content from CCMS

DLZ Layout package: created with DOCUFY Layouter

- XSLT processing of content
- CSS modules imported by main.css

Microservice applies the XSLT to the content and calls AHF with the XML result and the main.css

Safety

Safe operation

Permissible maximum speed

The vehicle must be driven at the legally permitted maximum speed in the country of use. The vehicle may be damaged if the legally permitted maximum speed limit is permanently exceeded or is exceeded multiple times. This may result in claims for liability for defects being lost. The driver must reduce the vehicle speed independently if the maximum permissible speed is exceeded.

Intended use

The vehicle is designed exclusively for the transportation of goods. Any other use beyond this is considered improper use. If damages arise from improper use, the liable party is the operating company of the vehicle. The intended use is described in the respective functional description of the components.

Pay attention to the following information when operating the vehicle:

- Safety instructions in this Operator's Manual
- Technical Data in this Operator's Manual
- Operator's Manuals provided by the manufacturers of attachments, bodies and conversion parts
- Country-specific regulations

Improperly performed interventions and changes to the vehicle can lead to malfunctions and damage to the vehicle. Improperly performed interventions include but are not limited to changes to electronic components or the software and operation with service products which have not been approved by MAN. This may result in the invalidation of the operating permit, loss of insurance cover, or loss of any right to warranty claims as well as invalidation of the purchase guarantee.

Service products

When handling service products, observe the basic rules for occupa-

tional health and safety and hygiene in order to prevent any health damage.

Precautions for handling service products

- ▶ Avoid any prolonged, repeated and excessive skin contact with service products.
- ▶ Wear a suitable skin protection agent or protective equipment, e.g. protective gloves.
- ▶ Thoroughly wash skin which has been contaminated by service products with water and soap.
- ▶ Apply a greasy skin cream after cleaning.
- ▶ Change any clothing which has come into contact with service products.
- ▶ Do not keep any cloths close to your body that have come into contact with service products.
- ▶ Dispose of service products in a proper manner.
